

Upon completing the studies in Political Science, the graduate holds tertiary education in political science and public administration, as well as other disciplines within the field of social sciences and humanities. The graduate holds broad, interdisciplinary knowledge on characteristics of political phenomena and processes, as well as various determining factors of those phenomena and processes. This knowledge – shaped during courses in political science, as well as philosophy, sociology, psychology, political history, management – allows the graduates to understand the complicated mechanisms of political life, within the state and state, as well as on the international and local levels.

Thanks to studying in English, the graduates are very well prepared to work in an international environment, and with the basic course of Polish, they may function well in mixed teams.

The graduate can apply scientific methods to analyze the complex social and political reality, to forecast tendencies and development directions and to design measures and strategies of its practical transformation. The graduate can collect, order and prioritize information on social and political phenomena and processes, to analyses and design functioning of political agents, such as social groups, political parties, public organs, decision-making centers, as well as to understand the role of needs, interests and value systems of individuals, groups and organizations – motivating them to political actions, further to explain circumstances and course of cooperation and conflicts between political agents, explain decision-making processes, create and implement political projects, e.g. political campaigns. They can apply various methods and techniques of affecting political behaviors of participants of political and – more broadly – social life.

By completing the obligatory courses, the graduate gains basic education in political science, complemented by the selected specialization.

The graduate of the Global Security specialization holds knowledge on threats to the modern international order and methods to counteract them. The acquired knowledge allows them to diagnose threats to the modern social, political and economic order. Therefore, the graduate of the Global Security specialization is a perfect candidate to work in crisis management centers, international organizations and international associations specializing in promoting human rights, solving armed conflicts, etc.

The graduate of the Media and Politics specialization displays knowledge and practical skills within social and political communication. They may work as a media advisor, media content creator, specialist for media in politics, social communication specialist. Potential employers for the graduate include advertising agencies, market research institutes, PR departments of public and commercial institutions, media organizations, non-governmental organizations, political organizations, development agencies and public administration units.

The graduate of the Comparative Politics specialization displays knowledge and skills needed to perform comparative analyses which may be applied in further scientific development at Master or Doctoral curricula. Those skills are also valuable for employers, both within the public and private sectors.

The Europe in the World specialization provides interdisciplinary understanding of functioning of the European Union and its role as a global actor. It focuses on internal and external aspects of the European integration from the political, economic and social perspective. To some extent, the specialization responds to Euro-sceptic trends arising largely from a lack of knowledge of the objectives, structure and benefits of functioning of the European Union, as well as its policies. The specialization provides the students with a possibility to discuss and understand the complex or controversial questions concerning Europe.
